**Course Overview:**

This is the second in a two course series. The two courses provide an introduction to the Sanskrit language. We will cover noun and pronoun declensions, verb conjugations, *sandhi*, compounds, and so on.

**Required Readings:**

Madhav M. Deshpande, *Samskratasubodhini: A Sanskrit Primer* (Ann Arbor, MI: Centers for South and Southeast Asian Studies, University of Michigan, 2003).

**Evaluation:**

Students will take a quiz every other week. There will also be a final writing assignment – a translation – due April 20<sup>th</sup> in my assignment drop box, SS 12<sup>th</sup> floor. Participation and homework count heavily toward the final grade.
