#### **COURSE OBJECTIVE:**

This course will provide an introduction to the ancient novel. Assessments will be based on texts interpreted in class, so attendance is essential.

# **COURSE REQUIREMENTS**:

1. An essay of 1500 words, due mid-term (Feb 27). Essay questions will be distributed. Each question will involve the analysis of <u>two</u> of the authors studied in class. The essay will require a bibliography of at least six items (two of which must be books). 30%

2. An essay of 2000 words, due at the end of term (Apr 4). Essay questions will be distributed. Each question will involve the analysis of <u>two</u> of the authors studied in class (different to those discussed in the first essay). The essay will require a bibliography of at least six items (two of which must be books). 40%

3. Class participation: three factual quizzes. (3 @ 10%) 30%

(Essays must be submitted on or before the due dates by 4.30pm. They should be submitted electronically and they will be returned electronically. Extensions must be finalized before the due date. Quizzes must be taken in the relevant session.)
