COURSE OBJECTIVE:

Students will learn the basic methodology of historical study and attempt to show their understanding in written work.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS:

3 written assignments (c. 2000 words each) on topics from lists provided by instructor (each worth 30% of the grade for the course; due dates 11 February; 11 March; 15 April)	90%

Essays must be submitted on or before due dates.
