Textbook Jacob Weingreen, *A Practical Grammar for Classical Hebrew* (Oxford: Clarendon Press, 1959; 0198154224).

Description The course provides an introductory study of classical Hebrew grammar and literature. Prior knowledge of classical Hebrew is not required. The course emphasizes acquisition of practical reading and grammar skills; it is designed for Religious Studies majors who need to read the Bible in the original language. The course does not cover derivative Hebrew variants.
