Course description

An introduction to the critical study and reading of the books of the Hebrew Bible/Old Testament in English translation. The course focuses on the Bible as religious literature.

Course Requirements

- (20%) First written primary text analysis (26 Feb due in class 01 Mar; [5%/day late penalty])
- (20%) Second written primary text analysis (26 Mar due in class 29 Mar; [5%/day late penalty])
- (25%) quarterly examinations based on assigned textbook readings (27 Jan; 24 Feb; 24 Mar; 14 Apr; see note below)
- (35%) quarterly examinations based on assigned primary text readings (29 Jan; 26 Feb; 26 Mar; 16 Apr; see note below)

1. additional or alternative credit work will not be offered.
2. missed examinations: if an examination is missed for health reasons designated by the University as not requiring a physician's validation (H1N1) its credit weight will be transferred to the subsequent examination. (In the case of the final examination the weight will be transferred to the prior examination.)
